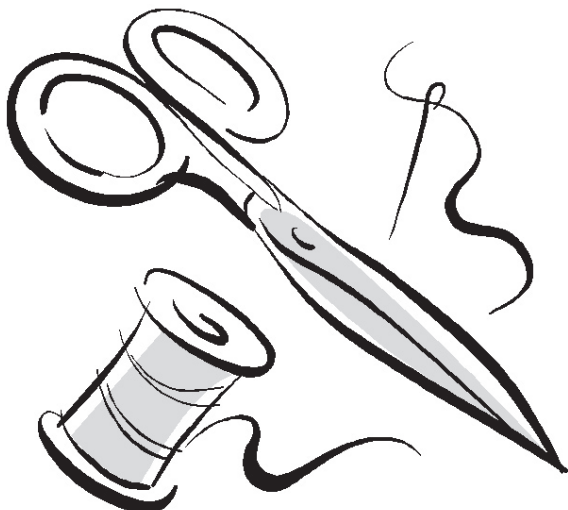

## Ruffled Blanket

Using worsted weight yarn, cast on 135 stitches. Using #13 needles, knit for 7 rows. Change to #3 needles and knit for 7 rows. Alternating between the two different sized needles and knitting 7 rows with each, continue to desired length.
